OBJECT LESSON

- 1) Fill a drinking glass $\frac{3}{4}$ full of water. ***Like the the glass is filled with water, many of use are filled with fears. You might be afraid of viruses, spiders, monsters, being alone in the dark, or many other things.***
- 2) Would you be afraid for someone to turn that glass upside down on your head? ***Everybody has fears, and so many times we don't want to face them.***
- 3) Cover mouth of glass with a thick, square piece of cardboard. Press it tightly against the glass and quickly turn cup upside down with your hand still pressing cardboard against glass. Slowly remove your hand, the cardboard should seal the glass not allowing water to come out. ***If we pray and place our trust in Jesus, He is like the cardboard who keeps our fears from crashing down on us or controlling us. We have no reason to fear the devil or evil if our faith is in Christ.***

SCAREDY SPIES NUMBERS 13-14



After God led the children of Israel out of Egypt, He continued to guide them to the land He had promised them. This promised land was Canaan. Finally, the Israelites reached the border of Canaan.



Moses, God's chosen leader of the Israelites, chose 12 men to go and spy out the land.



Even though the spies saw the land was excellent for growing crops and very beautiful, they also saw that there were powerful giants who lived in big cities in the land.



After 40 days, the spies returned to Moses. 10 of the spies told Moses that they should not go into Canaan for it was too dangerous. But, 2 other spies, Joshua and Caleb, brought back fruit from Canaan to show everybody how good the land was.



Joshua and Caleb told the Israelites that they didn't need to be afraid because God was on their side and would help them win against the giants. However, the Israelites didn't listen to Joshua and Caleb, and they believed the other 10 spies and were too scared to claim Canaan. Because the Israelites gave into their fears instead of trusting God, God didn't give them their promised land until 40 years later when the people were willing to trust God for victory.
